At this time we are seeking businesses or organizations interested in providing food for the event, especially on July 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>. It is our intent to allow street vendors to set up to sell any variety of food and beverage items.

- Suggestions for vendors would be hot dogs, hamburgers, watermelon, corn on the cob, ice cream, water, lemonade, fry bread, Indian taco, cotton candy
- We will reserve the right to limit the number of street vendors and the type of food served. This will be determined on a first come, first served basis. Sign up early, if you are interested.
- Each vendor will be responsible for providing their own power and vendor booth
- All vendors must comply with County Health Department regulations. A Serve Safe Food service class may be available through the Fergus County Extension Office.
- Vendor spaces can be reserved by submitting a completed application and the \$50 fee. The \$50 fee will be returned to you when your site is cleaned up, at the conclusion of the event. If you cancel with less than fourteen days notice your fee will be retained by the reunion committee

This will be an exciting time for the town of Hobson, and a good opportunity for your organization. I have enclosed a tentative schedule of events, as well as a vendor application. We look forward to hearing from you!
